

Application procedure for Onsite Training in Earth-Space Frontier Science

1. Objective

IGPEES aims to train excellent students who already have a strong basis in their specialized fields to obtain ability to independently create new research fields by combining different subject areas. Onsite Training in Earth-Space Frontier Science is one of the requirements to complete IGPEES. The following guidelines set the requirements for the application.

2. Period and activities

- (1) An assignment abroad
- (2) A corporate internship
- (3) Joint research at other universities or research institutions

Note that each student must participate in one of three activities listed above. Students are expected to participate in the activity for longer than two weeks. Students may combine more than one activities if the total period exceeds two weeks, however, it is not allowed to include more than one corporate internship in the plan.

3. Application procedure

Students are required to submit an application form (form 1) and a report (form 2) of the activity to the WINGS Desk within two weeks after they return. If students plan to combine several activities, the report must be submitted within two weeks after completing all of the activities. The program committee will review the report to decide whether to approve the application for the completion of IGPEES.

4. Proposal

It is also possible to submit a proposal to the WINGS Desk for review in advance to confirm whether the plan satisfies the program requirements. Those wishing to be considered must submit the application forms (form 1 and 3). The result of the proposals submitted before the 10th of every month will be notified by the end of the same month.
